3.	Participate in a Fight in any Public Place.	Section 2.3	\$300.00
4.	Mark or apply Graffiti on any Public Place, including signs or private property.	Section 2.4	\$300.00
5.	Leave, throw or deposit any bottles, glasses or material on public or private property.	Section 2.5	\$300.00
