

7. LIBRARY SERVICES

7.1 Circulation

7.1.1 Membership and Registration

1. RESIDENTS

DEFINITION

Persons who reside in Port Colborne or pay taxes on a business or any other property in Port Colborne.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED

- (a) **ADULTS (age 16)**: Two (2) pieces of identification must be shown, one of which must have name and current address.
- (b) **CHILDREN (under age 16)**: Parent or Legal Guardian must be present to provide the information required to obtain an adult membership, co-sign child's card and assume responsibility for all materials borrowed in his/her name

FEES

- (a) No membership fee.
- (b) Replacement fee for lost cards.

RESTRICTIONS

- (a) **ADULTS**: None.
- (b) **CHILDREN**: No adult audio-visual materials, no interlibrary loans.

2. NON-RESIDENTS

DEFINITION

Persons who reside outside of Port Colborne but within the Escarpment area, and their household does not pay taxes on a business or any other property in Port Colborne.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED

Same as for residents above.

FEES

Same as for residents above.

RESTRICTIONS

- (a) **ADULTS**: No interlibrary loans.
- (b) **CHILDREN**: No adult audio-visual materials, no interlibrary loans.

3. **TEMPORARY RESIDENTS**

DEFINITION

Persons who have a permanent residence outside the Escarpment Area.

Examples:

- (a) People whose permanent residence is outside the Escarpment area, and rent a cottage within the Escarpment area for the summer months.
- (b) People who are staying in motels / campgrounds in the Escarpment area.
- (c) Actors or other workers on temporary work assignment in the Escarpment area.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED

- (a) Two (2) pieces of identification, one of which must have name and current permanent address.
- (b) Patron must also provide proof of temporary address.

FEES:

- (a) \$10.00
- (b) Replacement fee for lost cards.

RESTRICTIONS

- (a) 4-month membership.
- (b) No inter-library loan service.
