We are applying for a special occasion permit (it is a 1 week allowance for licencing for special events) for our small patio.

It would run for 1 week at Canal Days and 1 week at Labour day weekend. This would create 6-8 seats. The patio is not licensed at this time, as it took too long for us to complete it, and there was not enough time to apply and receive a license. We will license patio next year.

This is not encroaching on City property, nor does it affect our parking, as we have just had our lot redone and have 9 spots now allowing for 36 seats. We have 28 inside and 8 outside=36.

We need Council's approval asap, as we just became informed of this special events allowance on Wed July 3rd and have to submit all approvals by the 10th.
