RE: Cruise Nights Association – Temporary Road Closure By-law


Since their inception the Cruise Night Association weekly classic car show has enjoyed tremendous success demonstrating continued participation growth and positively impacting the community on many fronts. The City core has seen a hub of pedestrian activity along Clarence St., participating businesses have benefited and local charitable and community groups have taken full advantage to boost their fundraising opportunity. More importantly the economic and tourism impact has been measureable and continues to show increasing momentum.

Following a meeting with the Cruise Night Association and city staff July 28, 2014 to discuss the logistics to extend temporary road closure and amend the current by-law. It was determined that to facilitate the growth of the weekly car show a temporary road closure from the western limit of Clarence & Catherine streets to the eastern limit of Clarence and Elm Streets would be required; and that this closure would be approved pending consent from the local businesses (namely Food Basics, *7 Eleven and *Shoppers Drug Mart). In addition this temporary road closure would require the intersection at Clarence and Elm streets to be properly manned with appropriate signs directing motor vehicle traffic open to these businesses, refer Appendix A. (*Note: 7 Eleven has indicated that the temporary road closure is fine for now; and Shoppers Drug Mart has indicated that the temporary road closure is good for the next two weeks – Jul 31 and Aug 7 – following a review of retail sales).

Additionally, the Market Square will also be incorporated as an additional site to host car show participants for over flow and to host specific theme nights. The Market Square municipal parking lot would be used weekly during the designated Cruise Nights from 5:00 to 9:00 PM; and required August 7, September 11 and 18 from 3:00 to 9:00 PM for special theme nights.

For the temporary road closure and Market Square closure to take effect the provision of a by-law is required; and that the City Clerk be directed to prepare the appropriate by-law for City Council to authorize.

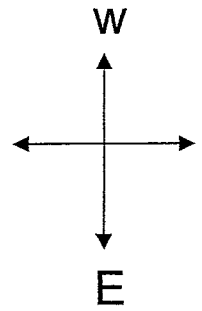
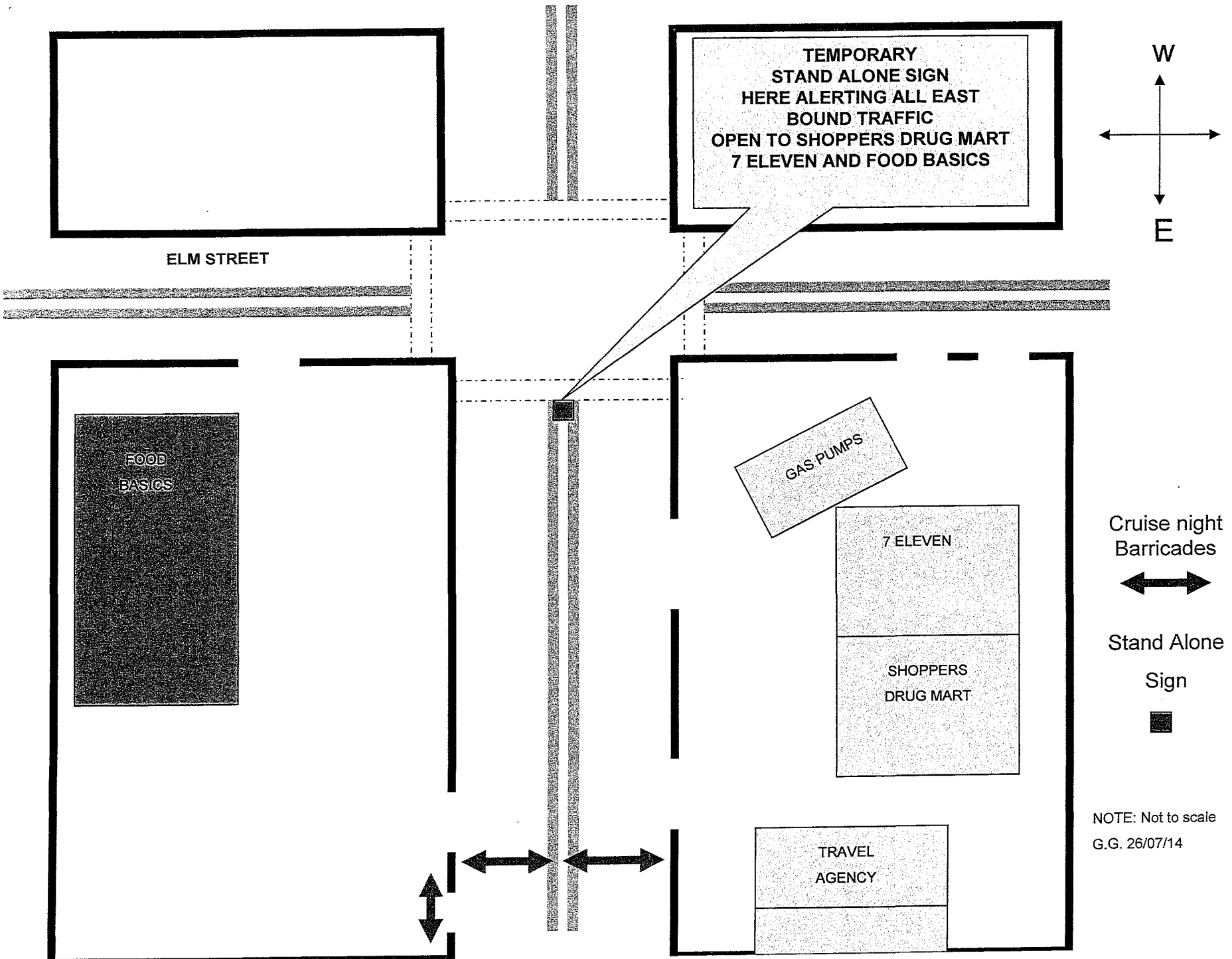

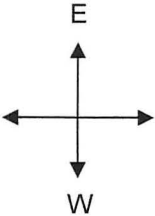
