



ARE YOU RUNNING FOR REGIONAL COUNCIL?

NIAGARA REGION PROVIDES:

CHILDREN'S SERVICES for more than 15,000 children from birth to 12 years, including five child care centres.

SOCIAL ASSISTANCE AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES managing the Ontario Works program for thousands of residents.

SENIORS SERVICES for 1,500 seniors at eight long-term care homes and the T. Roy Adams Regional Centre for Dementia Care plus community programs serving more than 4,000 seniors and family members annually.

HOMELESSNESS SERVICES homeless outreach, and homelessness prevention support to more than 9,000 people annually.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES provides emergency pre-hospital care by paramedics and system status controllers, with 17 bases and one community response unit. Niagara EMS manages over 80,000 9-1-1 ambulance calls managing the Ontario Works program for thousands of residents.

WASTEWATER: In 2017, 75 billion litres of wastewater was treated at 11 plants, and collected through 113 pump stations and 285 km of wastewater mains

WATER SERVICES: In 2017, 57 billion litres of potable water was produced at six plants and transmitted through 39 facilities and 323 km of water mains.

PUBLIC HEALTH provides health protection, disease prevention, health promotion, and injury prevention programs with over 105,000 residents participating in clinics, classes, and workshops each year. Regional Council also serves as Board of Health to ensure Public Health meets its legislated mandate.

WASTE MANAGEMENT collects recyclables, organics and garbage, operates a recycling facility, three active landfill sites, four drop-off centres and 11 closed landfill sites.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES is responsible for the planning, design, construction and maintenance of approximately 770 km of major arterial roads, including bridges, culverts, signs and traffic signals.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT facilitates business and tourism growth and competitiveness, and promotes Niagara globally as a uniquely diversified and sustainable regional economy.

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES creates healthy and prosperous communities through responsible land-use planning focused on economic prosperity. Provides services through the divisions of Development Services, Community and Long-Range Planning and Infrastructure Planning and Development Engineering.

PROVINCIAL OFFENCES COURT SERVICES operates the Provincial Offences courts on behalf of the Province of Ontario, processing tickets for tens of thousands of residents each year.

SERVICES FOR MUNICIPALITIES on a cost recovery basis (human resources, financial services, etc.).

NIAGARA REGION PROVIDES FUNDING, AND GOVERNANCE OVERSIGHT (THROUGH BOARD MEMBERSHIP), FOR THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

NIAGARA REGIONAL HOUSING provides and advocates for affordable housing, including more than 850 family homes and more than 1,830 seniors apartments, plus a rent supplement program, housing allowances, new development and nonprofit/co-op housing units.

NIAGARA PENINSULA CONSERVATION AUTHORITY establishes and undertakes programs to further the conservation, restoration, development and management of natural resources within its jurisdiction.

NIAGARA REGIONAL POLICE SERVICE provides policing and public safety services to residents and 14 million visitors yearly.
