**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**BY-LAW AMENDMENT TO PARKING & TRAFFIC BY-LAW 89-2000  
DELETING THEREFROM THE PARKING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2AM- 6AM  
AMENDING THERETO THE PARKING INTERFERING WITH STREET CLEANING  
MEASURES, AND THE CLEARING OF SNOW FROM THE HIGHWAY**

Owner of vehicles within the City of Port Colborne are hereby notified of a change to the Parking and Traffic By-law 89-2000 as amended.

Section 205.01 "Subject to Sections 203 and 204, no person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked on any highway."

205.01.11 "Between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m." DELETED

205.01.12 "In such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic, street cleaning measures or the clearing of snow from the highway" ADDED

Upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of the above mentioned, an officer will Red Tag the vehicle (once only) as a warning for it to be moved. Failure to comply with the warning will result in a parking infraction notice (ticket) and/or the vehicle to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the Repair and Storage Liens Act.

Your co-operation in complying with these provisions would be appreciated and would avoid the use of the enforcement provisions of the Bylaw/Act

Vehicle -"includes a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road- building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by and kind of power, including muscular power, but does not include a motorized snow vehicle or a street car"

Large Motor Vehicle - "means a commercial motor vehicle, bus, school bus, boat, boat trailer, or mobile home"
