b) Holiday Season Hours of Operation

The board reviewed the holiday operating hours of the other 12 libraries in Niagara. Seven libraries were closed December 31st and five were open only for a half day.

c) New Electronic Resources: "Mango"

The Southern Ontario Library Service, in collaboration with Ontario Library Services North, has confirmed the revised core suite of e-resources for the next three years. These products are funded by the Ontario Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport to ensure equitable access to information for all Ontarians through their public libraries. The Ministry has committed \$1.8 million to this project for each of the next three years.

The library's newest e-resource title is <u>Mango Languages</u>. This subscription includes unlimited remote access to 49 basic language courses, an adult module, a children's version and an English as a second language module. Web-based and remotely accessible, patrons can access it anywhere they get online. All they need is their library card number.

The library will no longer normally purchase language instruction titles in CD or DVD formats. Mango Languages is being promoted on the library's website as well as in the City Hall News scheduled for November 29, 2012.
