Watershed Conditions Statement

This notice is intended to update the public and local municipalities of the condition of Lake Ontario as it relates to the Niagara Peninsula and the eastern portion of the City of Hamilton.

The Niagara Peninsula and portions of Hamilton and Haldimand are currently receiving an intense rain event. This event has dropped a considerable amount of rain over a short period of time. This event may impact smaller watercourses in our jurisdiction and localized flooding may occur. All major watercourses are well below critical levels. This event is forecasted to last until early evening.

The NPCA will continue to monitor these conditions and will issue further messages as required. Information on the Flood Status in the watershed and water levels within the streams can be found on the NPCA's website at:
