The City of Port Colborne is issuing this Request for Proposal (“RFP”) to solicit competitive Proposals from qualified, professional firms for the supply and installation of a pylon ground sign and the removal of the existing pylon sign at the Vale Health and Wellness Centre (VHWC) in the City of Port Colborne (the “Project”). The Project entails the purchase and supply of a pylon ground sign, including installation of the unit, along with, removal of the existing pylon sign.
