Port Colborne, ON (Dec.1, 2020) – Port Colborne has established a cross-functional team of City staff to coordinate and accelerate the review of development proposals and investment inquiries to align with business expectations and support their timelines for decision-making.

This new “City Development Team” initiative follows through on a recommendation in the City’s 2018-2028 Economic Development Strategy and Action Plan to: “Prioritize a ‘Customer First’ service experience and Review Development Application Policies and Procedures.”

These changes also align with the Customer Relationship Management (CRM) project underway that is focused on enhancing the overall customer service experience through communications and technology improvements, a new website, staff training, and creating more coordination and integration among City departments when responding to resident and business inquiries.

The Development Team meeting will be comprised of key staff from:

- Economic Development and Tourism Services
- Engineering and Operations
- Office of the CAO
- Planning and Development
