Motorists and the general public are hereby advised that Regional Road 98 (Wilhelm Rd.) from Highway 3 to Forks Rd. E. will be closed weekdays from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. to facilitate the echelon paving of this roadway.

Closure will take place on:

 Tuesday November 9, 2021 to Friday November 19, 2021, weekdays 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

The detour route for the closure is as follows:

RR98 (Schill Rd.) / RR25 (Netherby Rd.) / RR84 (Miller Rd.) / Highway 3

Construction Zone:

Regional Road 98 (Wilhelm Rd.) From Highway 3 to Forks Rd E.

Businesses and residents will have access during the closure but may be directed to take an alternate route to get to their destination.

Emergency services will also have access if required.
