Will any occupants/ tenants remain in any building on the site during demolition?		
Is the building a school? If this applies, Ministry of Education approval is required.

Is the building located within 4.5 metres of municipal right-of way? If the municipal right-of-way is		
being used a Municipal Consent permit is required along with a demolition permit.
