GUIDELINES FOR POOL PERMITS



WHEN AND WHY DO YOU NEED A BUILDING PERMIT?

According to Article 3.1.1 of our Pool By-Law:

"No person shall erect, construct or install any privately owned outdoor swimming pool capable of containing water to a depth of more than 0.60 metres (2 ft) at any point without first obtaining a permit from the City of Port Colborne."

The purpose of a Building Permit is to ensure construction is done safely and appropriately for the space available, that the Ontario Building Code and By-Laws are adhered to. A Building Permit legally authorizes you to start construction in accordance with approved drawings and specifications.

If you are also building a deck with your swimming pool, make sure to check our Decks Guide and to apply for a Building Permit.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS YOUR PLAN MUST COMPLY TO



We'll look at where you plan to place your swimming pool to make sure it adheres to the <u>City's Zoning By-Law</u>.

We'll consider things like:

- Are the setbacks appropriate?
- Does your pool enclosure (fence and gate) plan comply with the By-Law?



We'll consider if your project meets the minimum design and building requirements set out in Section 9 of the <u>Ontario Building Code</u>.

We'll consider things like:

- Are the foundation and anchorage systems adequate?
- Is the framing and fastening plan adequate?
