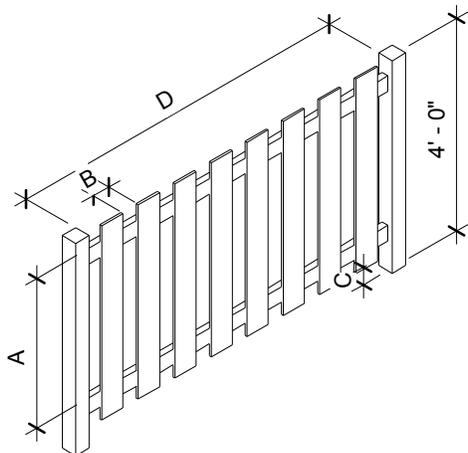


Fence Style Guide

Boards on one side



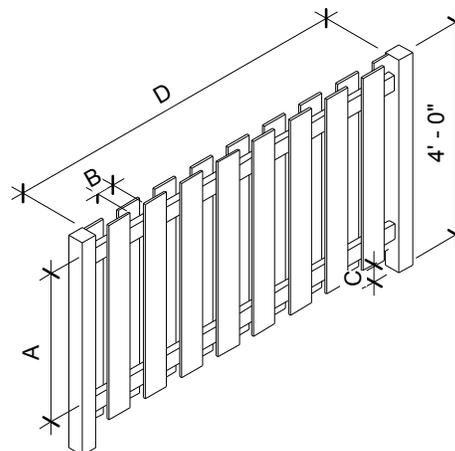
NOTES

4" spacing between boards (B), if rail spacing is < 3'-0" (A)
 2" spacing between boards (B), if rail spacing is > 3'-0" (A)

4" spacing from grade to board (C) if grade is concrete

(D) is max of 8'-0"

Boards on two sides



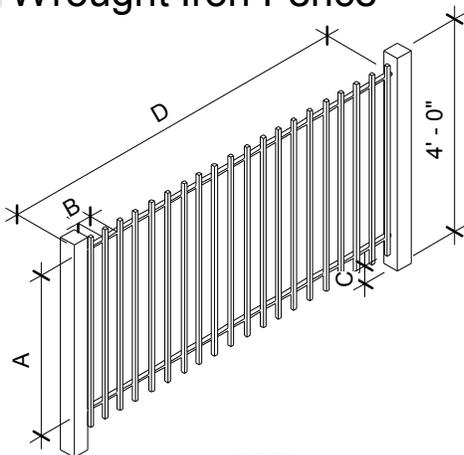
NOTES

4" spacing between boards (B), if rail spacing is < 3'-0" (A)

Wrought Iron Fence



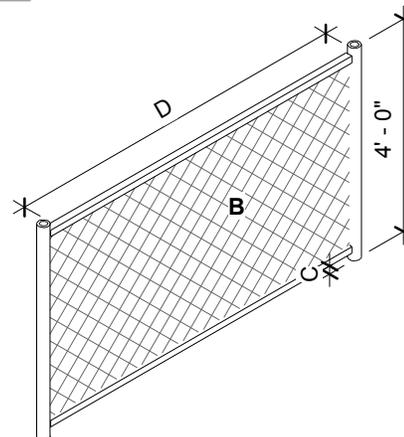
NOTES

4" spacing between pickets (B), if rail spacing is < 3'-0" (A)
 2" spacing between pickets (B), if rail spacing is > 3'-0" (A)

4" spacing from grade to picket (C) if grade is concrete

(D) is max of 8'-0"

Chain Link Fence



NOTES

50mm (2") spacing (B), if rail spacing is < 3'-0" (A)
 38mm (1.5") spacing (B), if rail spacing is > 3'-0" (A)

4" spacing from grade to picket (C) if grade is concrete
