BY-LAW NO. 5648/79/11

BEING A BY-LAW PROVIDING FOR THE NAME CHANGE OF OAKWOOD PARK TO HARRY DAYBOLL, OAKWOOD PARK AND TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 5503/100/10 BEING A BY-LAW TO MANAGE AND REGULATE MUNICIPAL PARKS

WHEREAS Oakwood Park is located at the corner of Westside Road and Omer Avenue:

AND WHEREAS a community petition from the Optimist Club of Port Colborne and Port Colborne District Scouts was submitted to the Manager of Community Services, requesting that Oakwood Park be renamed "Harry Dayboll, Oakwood Park";

AND WHEREAS Harry Dayboll assisted in the construction of the Scout Lodge at the rear of Oakwood Park in the former Township of Humberstone and has been a volunteer at the park and is the primary caretaker of the Scout Hall for over 50 years;

AND WHEREAS on June 13, 2011, Council approved Department of Community & Corporate Services, Community Services Division, Report No. 2011-17, Subject: Renaming Oakwood Park to Harry Dayboll, Oakwood Park, recommending that Council approve the request to change the name of Oakwood Park to Harry Dayboll, Oakwood Park and that staff negotiate with the organizations involved for possible cost sharing of a new park sign.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PORT COLBORNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Oakwood Park be renamed "Harry Dayboll, Oakwood Park".
- That Schedule "A" of By-law 5503/100/10, Being a By-law to Manage and Regulate Municipal Parks, be amended by replacing throughout the bylaw the words "Oakwood Park" with the words "Harry Dayboll, Oakwood Park".
- That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED BY COUNCIL THIS 13TH DAY OF JUNE, 2011.
