Instructions for Award Packet Requirements

1. Personal Letter from Applicant

Write a letter directed to the Port Colborne Medical Education, Recruitment and Health Services Committee describing your educational/medical career goals and how you intend to reach those goals. Describe the qualities you have developed that will help you succeed in obtaining your goals.

2. Essay

Write an essay that integrates the following topics:

- a. The medical profession you wish to pursue and why.
- b. Where you would want to practice as a medical professional and why.

Technical requirements for the essay

- a. Between 350 500 words
- b. Typewritten
- c. Double-spaced
- d. Paper-clipped (no staples please)

3. Activity Involvement

Please list the activities and community service that you have been involved in during high school.

4. Email or place the following in a 9" X 12" (letter sized) envelope:

- a. Completed Award Application Form
- b. Personal letter from applicant
- c. Essay

5. Return to High School Guidance Office

Guidance Office will forward one (1) candidate packet to the Medical Education, Recruitment and Health Services Committee to review and choose two (2) award recipients.
